Backsberg celebrates five generations of winemaking heritage. In the 1920s, the original barrel cellar was built on the farm. While it is no longer in use today, this Dry Red pays homage to humble beginnings and pursuing potential.

VITICULTURE

The fruit is from both younger vines, that drive the fruit profile, and low-yielding older vineyards, that provide a very finely structured backbone. Oakleaf and weathered granite soils ensure soils rich in organic matter.

VINIFICATION

A variety of Backsberg's premium red cultivars are blended together to create a soft, easy-drinking red wine. This wine incorporates portions of exceptional wines of various winemaking styles with high-quality oak aged components building a beautiful backbone. An approachable blend for everyday enjoyment.

TASTING NOTE

Designed for easy drinking, swirls of vanilla and liquorice move across the palate smoothly, while the lip-smacking softness demands another sip.
